

KAIROS PLACEMATS

These are a nice way of expressing love and support to all the candidates at one time. During the Kairos weekend, these placemats are placed on the tables during mealtime.

These placemats can be created by:

- Individuals
- Families
- Sunday School classes
- School classes
- Other Church groups

The placemats must not have glitter, glue or paste. It is best to use only markers or colored pencils to do agape placemats. Placemats should depict God's love and include the name of the individual or group giving the placemat (for children, first names and ages only, please). Placemats created by a group should be signed by each member of the group.

Use blank placemats provided by the Kairos Agape team. Adults may sign their full names, children first name and age only. No other personal information should be included.

The message on the placemat is to be an uplifting one conveying the Love of Jesus and the joy of knowing Him as friend and brother; the love that God has for all of his children, whether incarcerated or free.

A simple placemat might read: "Our prayers are with all the men of Kairos" and have everyone in your group sign their first names and ages. Then make sure that your group remembers to pray for the Kairos weekend.

Children may trace their hand prints all over the placemat and put their first name and age within the hand print.

Sample sayings or phrases you might use:

- Keep on trusting; Jesus loves you.
- Hang on, He is there for you.
- You can do all things through Christ who strengthens you.
- God bless you and keep you in the shadow of His wings.
- Jesu, joy of man's desiring.
- Jesus, He is the Resurrection and the Life
- May He keep you in Perfect peace as you keep your mind fixed on Him.
- His eye is on the sparrow and you know He watches over you.
- You are loved with His everlasting Love.
- Pray. God listens. Pray without ceasing.
