

**Sunday, March 24:** (concludes 40 Days for Life) With Easter in mind...

"At dawn on the first day of the week... there was a violent earthquake" (Mt 28:1-26).

In the Old Testament, earthquakes are a sign of the coming of God, the breaking in of the New Age in which God's kingdom will flourish. That is what happens of course at the Resurrection. A new chapter of history now begins in which the Risen Life of Christ is accepted by believers and overcomes humanities slavery to death.

#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

**Good Friday:** A day of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of one full meal for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Easter Duty Obligation: After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. If you have not been to Holy Communion for a year, you are required to make your Easter Duty. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but it is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.





**Swieconka** (sh-vee-en-soon-kah) is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions. Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and decorated with sprigs of boxwood (**bukszpan**), the typical Easter evergreen. This food is shared on Easter morning in a ritual breaking of the fast. Observing the beautiful foods and creations of other parishioners is one of the special joys of the event.
