

A Thank You, A Story and an Invitation

Thanks to the generosity of parishioners, last year Holy Spirit St. Vincent de Paul distributed \$144,349 to help with rent, utilities, medical and prescription bills, and transportation. We distributed an estimated \$21,432 in donated groceries to food insecure individuals and families, and that doesn't include the Thanksgiving and Christmas outreach. We prepared and served 1,100 hot breakfast meals for the homeless. We bought 186 age appropriate books about Jesus that we delivered to the children of families who received turkeys and food for Thanksgiving. Besides those who needed financial help, we made 678 visits to people who were sick, homebound, hospitalized or in nursing homes. As our founder said, "No work of charity is foreign to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.'


