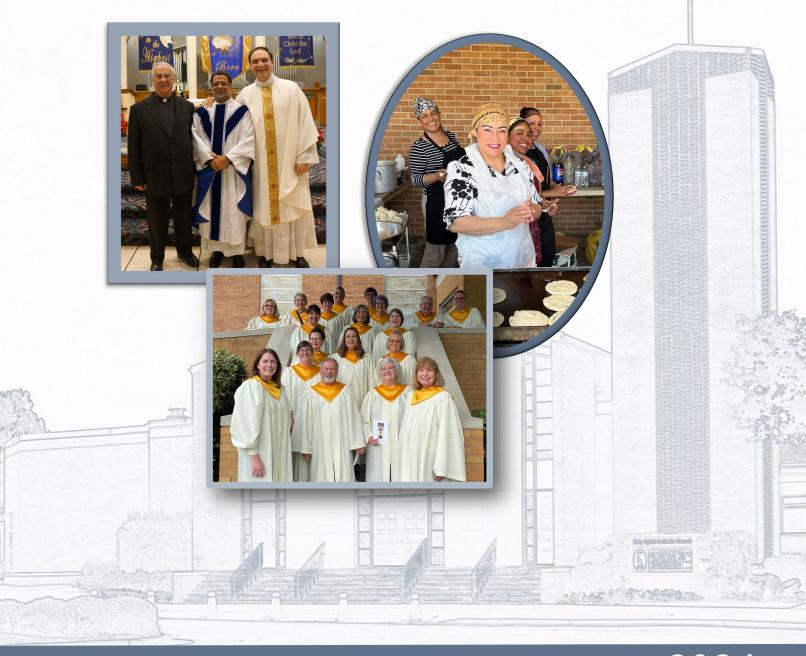

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

216 individuals were baptized in 2024.



173 children received the Sacrament of First Communion in 2024.

184 individuals received the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2024.



47 couples entered into the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony in 2024.





OCIA CANDIDATES

31 individuals were received fully into the Catholic Church through our OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) Classes in 2024.

Parish general revenue in 2024 was \$2,590,712.96, of which 87% or \$2,259,968.53 was general offertory, 11% or \$279,744.68 was Development Fund, and 2% or \$50,999.75 was Other Income.

Our parish is truly blessed by the generosity of its parishioners. In 2024, Program Revenues totaled \$152,943.26. This included donations and fees to education and youth programming, flower donations, and parish hall rentals.

*In 2024, end-of-the-year gifts began to be tracked as Other Income. In previous fiscal years, such gifts were categorized as Weekly Offering.

**In 2024, we held our first Pentecost Parish Festival, and the income received from that event was used to support our parish programming. In Spanish, such a Parish Festival is traditionally called a "Kermes".

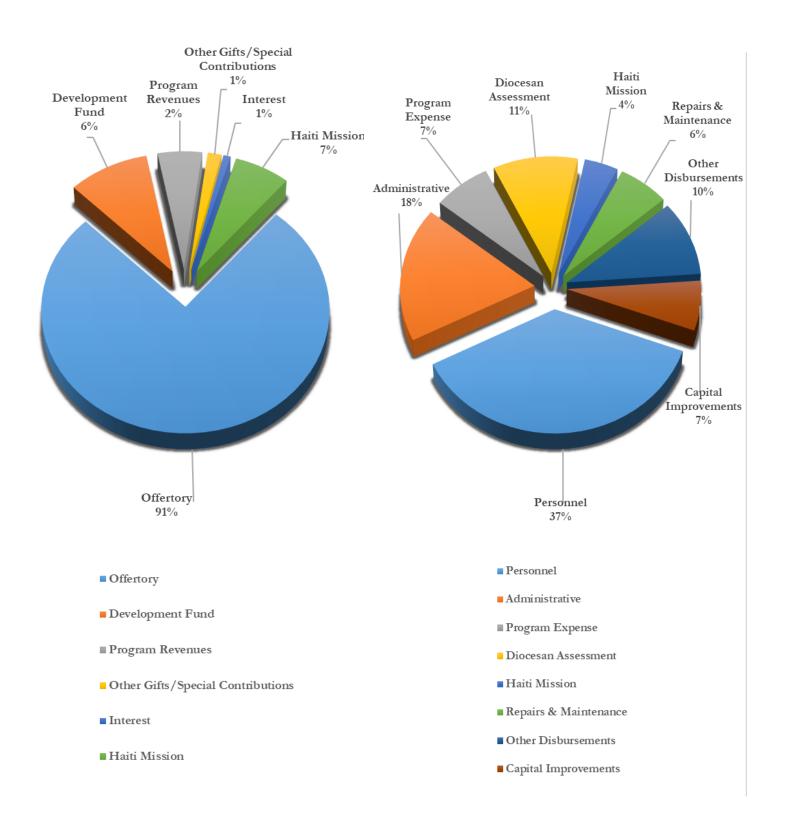

Total personnel expense totaled \$1,106,618.96, which includes salaries and fringe benefits for the parish staff. Total Administrative Expense totaled \$921,162.92 of which the largest items include insurance, repairs & maintenance, diocesan assessment, and utilities. Program expense totaled \$212,414.29 and includes expenses related to religious education, music, and parish social events. Other disbursements totaled \$302,540.86, which includes school subsidies, donations to local charities, donations on behalf of the parish to the Haiti Mission, and gifts. Within the category of Other Disbursements, in 2024 a one-time gift of \$100,000 was offered on behalf of the parish to the renovation of the Monastery at St. Bernard's Abbey in Cullman, AL.

^{*}The commercial insurance payment for 2023 was paid out over a period of several months, meaning several payments were disbursed in 2024. For 2024, we opted to pay the sum total at once, thus receiving a discount. For this reason, there is a larger percentage difference between the two fiscal years.

^{**}Funds used for capital improvements had largely been saved from prior fiscal years from donations to the Development Fund. Please see page 7 for more information concerning the Development Fund.

THE DEVELOPMENT FUND

Thanks to the generosity of our many parishioners, throughout the 2024 Fiscal Year many projects were completed in order to update or renovate major areas of the physical plant of our parish church. These projects were completed using funds that had been saved in the Development Fund. Since over the years the Development Fund had grown to a healthy amount, it was decided that projects throughout the physical plant should be identified for renovation and categorized by priority.

In determining which projects are eligible to be completed using the Development Fund, the Finance Council makes its recommendation to the Pastor or his delegate according to the following criteria:

- An asset that is capitalized according to the Parish Capitalization Policy adapted in 2020
- Building renovation expense
- Building growth or expansion expense
- Not to be used for routine repairs or maintenance

Below is a listing of the many wonderful projects that have been completed due to the collections saved in the Development Fund.

- Total renovation of the Bridal Room
- Total renovation of the Multipurpose Room
- Total renovation of the Parish Bookstore
- Replacing one of the 30-year-old HVAC systems in the Church
- Replacing 30-year-old Fan Coil units in the Activity Center
- Relocation of our internet server to a more secure location
- Replacing HVAC Grills in Church

All these projects were completed without any extra fundraising efforts thanks to the generosity of our parishioners!

The importance of this annual report is that it supports in documentary form that the temporal goods of our parish are being used for the proclamation of the Gospel through participation in the Sacramental life of the Church and through formation and evangelization.
