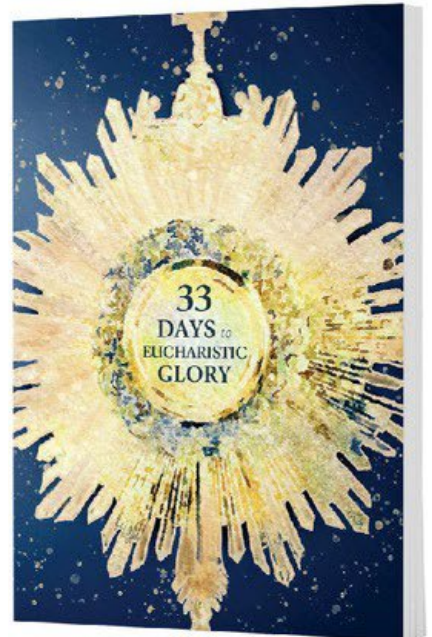

You are mine.* And this is His invitation: “Come to me, all of you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.” (Matthew 11:28)
