

Bishop Raica Names Fr. Michael Mac Mahon Pastor Emeritus of Holy Spirit Parish

As you know, this year Father Mike Mac Mahon has been Pastor of Holy Spirit Parish for almost 22 years. We have been tremendously blessed by his spiritual and personal leadership of our parish family. His pastoral insight, his dedication to our formation in Christ, and his quick wit have been gifts to lead us through our joys as well as our trials.



With gratitude for more than 58 years of priestly ministry to the people of God throughout the Diocese of Birmingham, Bishop Raica has granted

Father Mike retirement status. This will be effective on February 24, and Father Mike will receive the title of Pastor-Emeritus of Holy Spirit Catholic Parish. Father Mike will continue to reside in the rectory of the parish, and we will begin planning a celebration of gratitude for him in the near future.

In the meantime, Father Bazzel, Vicar General of the Diocese and Former Associate Pastor of Holy Spirit Parish, will assume the role of temporary Administrator of the parish as the Bishop seeks to name a new Pastor by July of this year. Father Bazzel will continue to reside in Birmingham while assisting with the overall governance of the parish. Father Daniel and Father Jose will continue to provide for the ongoing daily care of the parish community.

We thank God for having given us Father Mike as our faithful shepherd for these past many years, and we look forward as a parish community to thanking Father Mike for his devoted priestly labors on our behalf.


Help Provided
