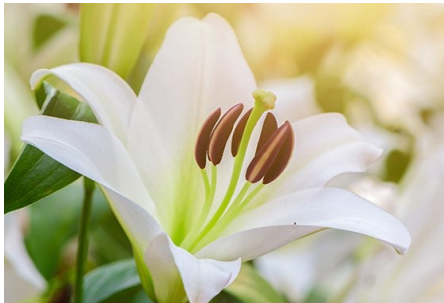

Clergy Corner - From Fr. Daniel

"For the infant Church, 'Palm Sunday' was not a thing of the past. Just as the Lord entered the Holy City that day on a donkey, so too the Church saw him coming again and again in the humble form of bread and wine" (Pope Benedict XVI, Jesus of Nazareth, Holy Week, p. 10). The celebration of Holy Week begins our reliving what the Ancient Israelites celebrated when they celebrated Passover and what Jesus fulfilled in Himself almost 2,000 years ago. The Book of Exodus enshrines God's command to celebrate the Passover: "You will keep this practice forever as a statute for yourselves and your descendants" (Exodus 12:24). We continue the celebration of the Passover Sacrifice by entering into the salvific actions of the fulfillment of the Passover Lamb, Jesus Christ. Two attributes mark our celebrations of these most sacred days of Holy Week: processions and time.

Each of the Holy Week liturgies is defined by a procession. Today, Palm Sunday, we process from the school to the church while holding palm branches, because that is what Jesus did when He entered into Jerusalem. On Holy Thursday, we will process from the Church to the Parish Life Center and pray in silence with Jesus, because that is what the Apostles did after the Last Supper when they followed Jesus to the Garden of Gethsemane. On Good Friday, we will process forward to venerate the Cross, just as Jesus processed through the streets of Jerusalem to die on the Cross. On Holy Saturday, we will process from the Easter Fire into the Church, following the Light of Christ symbolized in the Paschal Candle, illustrating the procession from the tomb to eternal life. Processions are movements of people journeying together from a place of preparation to a place of celebration. Jesus invites us today to follow Him in procession into Jerusalem. We know that following Jesus always leads us to the Heavenly Jerusalem.

Secondly, all of the liturgies during Holy Week take time. They are not rushed. On Palm Sunday and Good Friday, we stand while we read from the Passion Narrative of Our Lord. This takes a lot of time, and even the youngest among us can start complaining of feet hurting. On Holy Thursday, we sit and watch while the priest washes the feet of twelve parishioners. On Holy Saturday, we add more readings from Scripture to the Mass. All of these ceremonies take time. But they are supposed to take time. These days are the most important days of the year. We are here because our Faith teaches us that Jesus instituted the Eucharist and the Priesthood, that Jesus died for love of us, that Jesus rose from the dead. Celebrating these holy days beautifully entails incorporating more actions and words into our worship than the normal Sunday liturgy asks us to do. This is because we are reliving what Jesus did almost 2,000 years ago. Many churches will spend this week talking about what Jesus did for us. We, this week, will get to spend time not just talking about what Jesus did but reliving it. And anything worth doing takes time to do.

Rincón del Clero - Mensaje del Padre Daniel

Para la Iglesia naciente, el "Domingo de Ramos" no era algo del pasado. Así como el Señor entró aquel día en la Ciudad Santa montado en un burro, así también la Iglesia lo veía venir una y otra vez en la forma humilde del pan y el vino" (Papa Benedicto XVI, Jesús de Nazaret: Desde la entrada en Jerusalén hasta la Resurrección, p. 10). La celebración de la Semana Santa marca el inicio de nuestro volver a vivir lo que los antiguos israelitas celebraban en la Pascua, y lo que Jesús cumplió en sí mismo hace casi 2,000 años. El Libro del Éxodo consagra el mandato de Dios de celebrar la Pascua: "Guardarás esto como norma perpetua, tú y tus hijos" (Éxodo 12,24). Nosotros continuamos celebrando el Sacrificio Pascual al participar de las acciones salvíficas del cumplimiento del Cordero Pascual, Jesucristo. Dos elementos marcan nuestras celebraciones de estos días más sagrados de la Semana Santa: las procesiones y el tiempo.

Cada una de las liturgias de la Semana Santa está definida por una procesión. Hoy, Domingo de Ramos, procesionamos desde la escuela hasta la iglesia con palmas en las manos, porque eso fue lo que hizo Jesús al entrar en Jerusalén. El Jueves Santo, procesionaremos desde la iglesia hasta el Centro Parroquial y oraremos en silencio con Jesús, porque eso fue lo que hicieron los Apóstoles después de la Última Cena cuando siguieron a Jesús al Huerto de los Olivos. El Viernes Santo, procesionaremos hacia adelante para venerar la Cruz, tal como Jesús procesionó por las calles de Jerusalén camino a la cruz. El Sábado Santo, procesionaremos desde el Fuego Pascual hacia el interior de la iglesia, siguiendo la Luz de Cristo simbolizada en el Cirio Pascual, ilustrando la procesión del sepulcro hacia la vida eterna. Las procesiones son movimientos de personas que caminan juntas desde un lugar de preparación hasta un lugar de celebración. Jesús hoy nos invita a seguirlo en procesión hacia Jerusalén. Sabemos que seguir a Jesús siempre nos lleva a la Jerusalén Celestial.

En segundo lugar, todas las liturgias de la Semana Santa toman tiempo. No se hacen con prisa. En el Domingo de Ramos y el Viernes Santo, permanecemos de pie mientras escuchamos la Narración de la Pasión del Señor. Esto toma mucho tiempo, y hasta los más pequeños entre nosotros pueden comenzar a quejarse de que les duelen los pies. El Jueves Santo, nos sentamos y observamos mientras el sacerdote lava los pies a doce feligreses. El Sábado Santo, añadimos más lecturas bíblicas a la Misa. Todas estas ceremonias requieren tiempo. Pero se supone que deben tomar tiempo. Estos días son los más importantes del año. Estamos aquí porque nuestra fe nos enseña que Jesús instituyó la Eucaristía y el Sacerdocio, que Jesús murió por amor a nosotros, que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos. Celebrar estos días santos de manera hermosa implica incorporar más acciones y palabras en nuestra adoración que las que normalmente hacemos en una liturgia dominical. Esto se debe a que estamos reviviendo lo que Jesús hizo hace casi 2,000 años. Muchas iglesias pasarán esta semana hablando de lo que Jesús hizo por nosotros. Nosotros, esta semana, tendremos la oportunidad de no solo hablar de lo que Jesús hizo, sino de revivirlo. Y todo lo que vale la pena hacer, vale la pena dedicarle tiempo.
