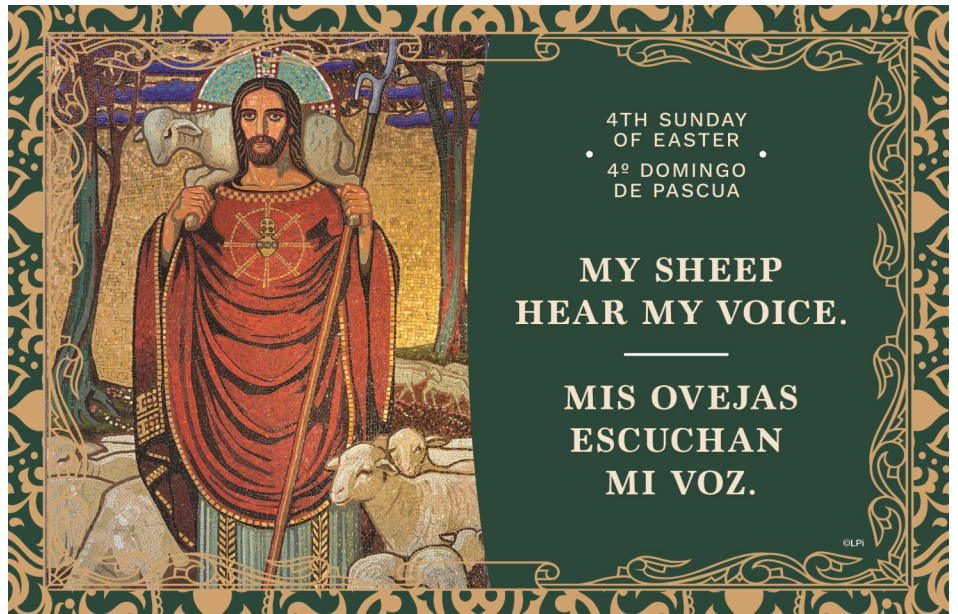

Clergy Corner - From Fr. Daniel

Today, we commemorate two very special celebrations. Firstly, **Happy Mother's Day** to all mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, and those women in our lives who have served as mother-figures for us! May you always experience the tenderness of Mary, Mother of the Church.

Secondly, today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, which is traditionally known as **Good Shepherd Sunday**. The Readings for the Fourth Sunday of Easter every year center on the beautiful and consoling image of Christ as the Good Shepherd.

The words of our Lord from the Gospel today are imbued with consolation and hope. Jesus says that He knows His sheep. How marvelous it is to be known by Jesus. He knows us better than anyone else on this Earth knows us—even our own mothers! He knows us, and He loves us. We are never strangers in our Father's house, but we are known and welcomed members of His family. Though there may be parts of our lives we wish Jesus didn't know about, He knows about them anyways, and He loves us anyways. That is why Jesus continues: "No one can take them out of my hand". His love for us and His desire for our salvation is so great that He holds us tightly in the palm of His hand like a shepherd who holds his sheep close to his heart when carrying it back to the flock.

Traditionally, Ordinations to the Priesthood in Rome would take place on Good Shepherd Sunday. Thus, each man ordained to the Priesthood would have before him the image of how his priesthood should be lived. He is to conform his life to Christ the Good Shepherd. He is to know the flock entrusted to his care and to seek out the lost and straying sheep with love. He is to care for the flock on this Earth so that they may all be gathered into the sheepfolds of Heaven forever. On May 31st, Bishop Raica will ordain Deacon Max Gallegos to the priesthood at the Cathedral of St. Paul in Birmingham. Please pray for Deacon Max as he seeks to conform his life to that of Christ the Good Shepherd. From our parish, John Gardiner and Cameron Huhlein continue their vocational journey of discerning God's plan for their lives, so please pray for them too. As always, pray for more vocations to the priesthood in the Diocese of Birmingham, especially from our parish. The vocation to the priesthood is a beautiful and mysterious one, and we thank God for all of the priests that He has placed in our lives, especially when we needed to be close to the heart of the Good Shepherd.

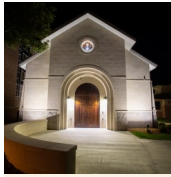
Rincón del Clero - Mensaje del Padre Daniel

Hoy conmemoramos dos celebraciones muy especiales. En primer lugar, **¡feliz Día de las Madres** a todas las madres, abuelas, madrinas y a aquellas mujeres en nuestras vidas que han sido figuras maternas para nosotros! Que siempre experimenten la ternura de María, Madre de la Iglesia.

En segundo lugar, hoy es el Cuarto Domingo de Pascua, conocido tradicionalmente como el **Domingo del Buen Pastor**. Las lecturas de este domingo, cada año, se centran en la hermosa y consoladora imagen de Cristo como el Buen Pastor.

Las palabras de nuestro Señor en el Evangelio de hoy están llenas de consuelo y esperanza. Jesús dice que Él conoce a sus ovejas. Qué maravilloso es ser conocido por Jesús. Él nos conoce mejor que cualquier otra persona en este mundo, ¡incluso mejor que nuestras propias madres! Nos conoce, y nos ama. Nunca somos extraños en la casa del Padre, sino miembros conocidos y bienvenidos de Su familia. Aunque haya partes de nuestra vida que quisiéramos que Jesús no conociera, Él las conoce de todas maneras, y aun así nos ama. Por eso Jesús continúa: "Nadie puede arrebatarnos de mi mano". Su amor por nosotros y su deseo de nuestra salvación es tan grande que nos sostiene con fuerza en la palma de su mano, como un pastor que lleva cerca de su corazón a la oveja perdida mientras la regresa al rebaño.

Tradicionalmente, las ordenaciones sacerdotales en Roma se celebraban en el Domingo del Buen Pastor. Así, cada hombre ordenado al sacerdocio tenía ante sí la imagen de cómo debía vivir su ministerio sacerdotal: conformando su vida a Cristo, el Buen Pastor. Debe conocer al rebaño que se le ha confiado y buscar con amor a las ovejas perdidas y descarriadas. Debe cuidar del rebaño aquí en la Tierra para que todos sean reunidos en los apriscos celestiales por toda la eternidad. El 31 de mayo, el Obispo Raica ordenará sacerdote al Diácono Max Gallegos en la Catedral de San Pablo en Birmingham. Por favor, recen por el Diácono Max mientras busca conformar su vida a la de Cristo, el Buen Pastor. Desde nuestra parroquia, John Gardiner y Cameron Huhlein continúan su camino vocacional discerniendo el plan de Dios para sus vidas, así que recen también por ellos. Como siempre, recemos por más vocaciones al sacerdocio en la Diócesis de Birmingham, especialmente desde nuestra parroquia. La vocación al sacerdocio es bella y misteriosa, y damos gracias a Dios por todos los sacerdotes que ha puesto en nuestras vidas, especialmente cuando más necesitábamos estar cerca del corazón del Buen Pastor.

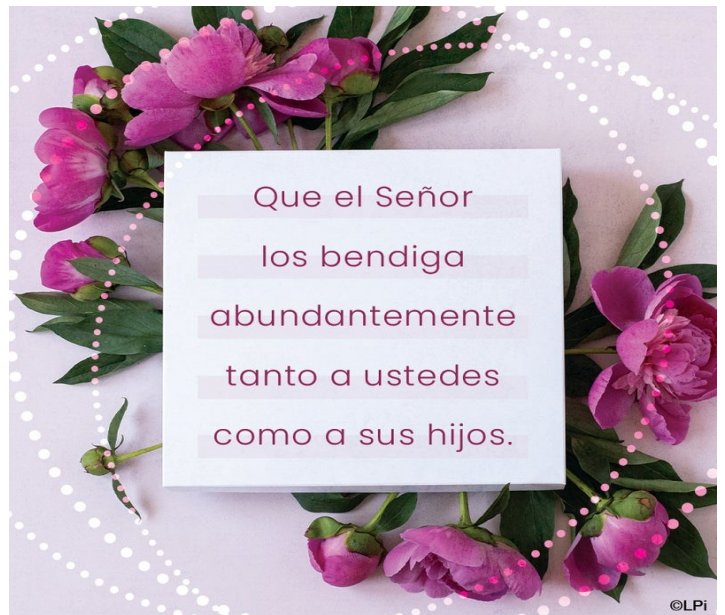

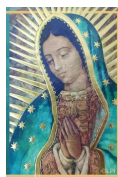
