Clergy Corner - From Fr. Daniel

"Habemus Papam!" With these words Cardinal Dominique Mamberti joyfully announced to the world the great joy that a new Pope had been elected. Approximately one hour later, Pope Leo XIV emerged on the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, clearly moved by the great and awesome task that had been entrusted to him. Yet, one could not detect fear in his face. Instead, his face emitted peace, the kind of peace that can only come from Christ. In fact, those were the first words he spoke to us as our Holy Father, the same words that the Resurrected Jesus spoke to his apostles: **"Peace be with you!"**

Though Pope Leo was born in the United States, his life has been marked by generous service to the Universal Church. After his ordination as an Augustinian priest in 1982, he received his doctorate in Canon Law from the Angelicum in Rome. From there, most of his priestly ministry would be spent in Peru, engaging in parish ministry and teaching Canon Law. In 1998, he was elected to serve as the Prior Provincial for the Midwest Province of Augustinians, and, three years later, he served as the Prior General over all of the Augustinians throughout the world. When his term concluded, he returned to parish ministry in Peru, where he served for barely a year when Pope Francis appointed him Bishop of Chiclayo in Peru. After about a decade of service, Pope Francis called him back to Rome to serve as the head of the Dicastery for Bishops, which assists the Pope in appointing Bishops throughout the whole world. Throughout all of these assignments, many interviews were conducted with Pope Leo, and one powerful observation stood out to me through all of these interviews: his spirituality informed by his love for St. Augustine is apparent.

Pope Leo shared with the world why he chose the name **"Leo"**. He tells us, **"I chose to take the name Leo XIV. There are different reasons for this, but mainly because Pope Leo XIII in his historic Encyclical Rerum Novarum addressed the social question in the context of the first great industrial revolution. In our own day, the Church offers to everyone the treasury of her social teaching in response to another industrial revolution and to developments in the field of artificial intelligence that pose new challenges for the defense of human dignity, justice and labor."** Rerum Novarum was an encyclical composed by Pope Leo XIII in 1891 to address how advancements during the Industrial Revolution often entailed the rejection of the dignity of the human person and how this is not compatible with the Gospel. Likewise, it seems that Pope Leo XIV will bring human dignity to the center stage of his papacy, especially as continued technological and industrial advancements often do come at the cost of cheapening the value of the human person.

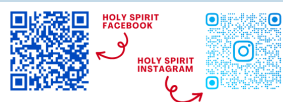

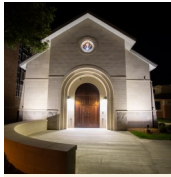
Rincón del Clero - Mensaje del Padre Daniel

"¡Habemus Papam!" Con estas palabras, el Cardenal Dominique Mamberti anunció con alegría al mundo la gran noticia de que un nuevo Papa había sido elegido. Aproximadamente una hora después, el Papa León XIV apareció en el balcón de la Basílica de San Pedro, visiblemente conmovido por la gran y admirable tarea que le había sido encomendada. Sin embargo, no se percibía temor en su rostro. En cambio, su rostro irradiaba paz, una paz que solo puede venir de Cristo. De hecho, esas fueron las primeras palabras que nos dirigió como nuestro Santo Padre, las mismas palabras que el Jesús Resucitado dirigió a sus apóstoles: **"¡La paz esté con ustedes!"**

Aunque el Papa León nació en los Estados Unidos, su vida ha estado marcada por un generoso servicio a la Iglesia Universal. Después de su ordenación como sacerdote agustino en 1982, obtuvo su doctorado en Derecho Canónico en el Angelicum de Roma. A partir de entonces, la mayor parte de su ministerio sacerdotal se desarrolló en Perú, donde trabajó en el ministerio parroquial y como profesor de Derecho Canónico. En 1998 fue elegido Prior Provincial de la Provincia del Medio Oeste de los Agustinos y, tres años más tarde, fue nombrado Prior General de todos los Agustinos del mundo. Al concluir su mandato, regresó al ministerio parroquial en Perú, donde sirvió por apenas un año hasta que el Papa Francisco lo nombró Obispo de Chiclayo, en Perú. Después de aproximadamente una década de servicio, el Papa Francisco lo llamó nuevamente a Roma para servir como prefecto del Dicasterio para los Obispos, que asiste al Papa en el nombramiento de obispos en todo el mundo. A lo largo de todas estas misiones, se llevaron a cabo muchas entrevistas con el Papa León, y una observación poderosa se destacó en todas ellas: su espiritualidad, influenciada por su amor a San Agustín, es evidente.

El Papa León compartió con el mundo la razón por la cual eligió el nombre "León". Él nos dice: **"Elegí tomar el nombre de León XIV. Hay diferentes razones para ello, pero principalmente porque el Papa León XIII, en su histórica encíclica Rerum Novarum, abordó la cuestión social en el contexto de la primera gran revolución industrial. En nuestros días, la Iglesia ofrece a todos el tesoro de su doctrina social como respuesta a otra revolución industrial y a los avances en el campo de la inteligencia artificial que presentan nuevos desafíos para la defensa de la dignidad humana, la justicia y el trabajo."**

Rerum Novarum fue una encíclica redactada por el Papa León XIII en 1891 para abordar cómo los avances durante la Revolución Industrial a menudo implicaban el rechazo de la dignidad de la persona humana y cómo esto no es compatible con el Evangelio. De manera similar, parece que el Papa León XIV colocará la dignidad humana en el centro de su pontificado, especialmente considerando que los avances tecnológicos e industriales continúan muchas veces a costa de menospreciar el valor de la persona humana.

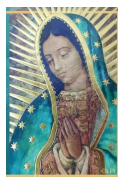
