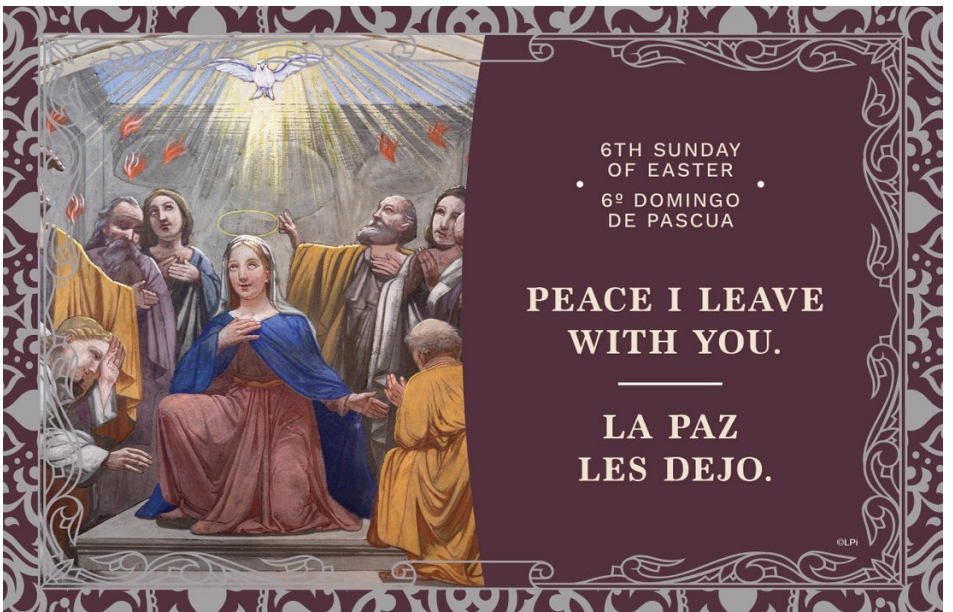

Clergy Corner - From Fr. Daniel

Last weekend, as you exited the Church after Mass, you received not only a bulletin but an invitation to attend all of the wonderful celebrations attached to our 60th anniversary! **We are celebrating our 60 years on the weekend of Pentecost, and I would like to personally invite each and every one of you to celebrate with us.**

On **Friday, June 6th**, we will have our usual schedule of **First Friday Masses**. There will be a **Holy Hour of Eucharistic Exposition before the noon Mass and after the 7:00 p.m. Mass**. In particular, these Holy Hours will center around praying for the families of our parish. Families of all ages, especially those with younger children who might normally feel self-conscious about spending lots of time in the Adoration Chapel, are welcome to attend. **After the noon Mass, we will have a cookout** instead of our usual First Friday Luncheon. The reason that we are not able to have our First Friday Luncheon in June is because our Knights of Columbus will be preparing our PLC for the **First Annual Seminarian Dinner**. This is a Diocesan-wide event intended to raise funds for seminarian education, and we are honored to be the hosts of this event! Bishop Raica and many of our seminarians will be in attendance. **Please speak with one of the Knights of Columbus about acquiring tickets.**

On **Saturday, June 7th**, our usual 5:00 p.m. Mass will be celebrated with extra joy and solemnity! **All are invited to mark this event on your calendar, as we will be celebrating our 60 years in a particular way during that Mass.** I would also encourage you to invite those in your family, in your neighborhoods, and in your communities who have not attended Mass in some time to join us. This is a special moment of celebration for us, and we have the wonderful opportunity to be evangelical witnesses to the Gospel by inviting them to draw closer once again to the sacramental life of the Church. **After Mass, there will be a reception in the PLC with desserts from various cultures, all representing our diverse worshipping community here at Holy Spirit.** We are excited to announce that Hatch will be catering our reception Saturday evening.

On **Sunday, June 8th**, the Knights of Columbus will offer a **donut Sunday** after the morning Masses. In the afternoon, on the day of Pentecost itself, we will be celebrating our **Parish Feast Day Festival from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.** This is a "come-and-go" event that will offer a variety of homemade foods, games, music, and an opportunity to win prizes at a raffle. In the Spanish language, this event is known as a "**Kermes**," which actually comes from the German "**Kirchmess**" and is a celebration for the feast day of the Parish. Each ticket is \$1, and all money raised will be kept here at Holy Spirit to help with future renovation projects. **All are invited to stop by, grab some delicious food, and enjoy celebrating our good and generous God.**

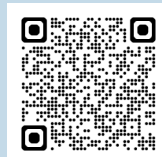

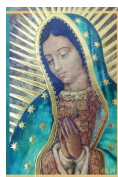

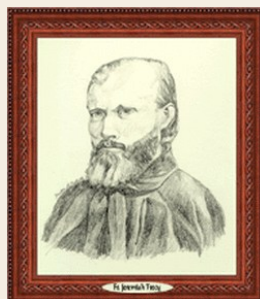
