Clergy Corner - From Fr. Daniel

The Easter Season, which is the time between Easter and Pentecost, is one of my favorite times of the year. There is the general sense of excitement and joy at the Resurrection of Our Lord which permeates other joyful celebrations during this time of the year: graduations, First Communion, Confirmations, and many other wonderful events. What contributes to this excitement, in my own experience, is the momentum that builds up from Easter to the celebration of Pentecost. During these fifty days, we are given readings in the Mass which provide us with insight into Christ forming His Church. This Sunday, our Scripture readings give us a glimpse into how Christ formed the heart of St. Peter to be the first Holy Father.

Our Gospel reading presents us with that very beautiful account of Jesus conversing with Simon Peter. Jesus's questioning of Peter three times reverses Peter's three denials of Jesus. Jesus then entrusts His sheep to the care of Peter, symbolizing Christ entrusting the members of His Body, the Church, to the watchful care of the Pope. Christ forms Peter's heart by inspiring love. This love is not abstract but is made concrete in Peter's caring for the flock which Christ entrusts to him. Interestingly enough, Peter is not given the sheep; he is only entrusted with feeding them and tending them. The sheep still are a part of Christ's flock. Peter has been placed over the sheep to care for them and protect them, but they are Christ's sheep. There is no "Peter's flock". Thus, Peter and all Popes after him are called to love Christ primarily in their mission of caring for the faithful.

This is why another title for the Pope is the **"Vicar of Christ"**. A **"vicar"** is one who acts in the name of another. The Pope sanctifies, teaches, and governs in the name of Christ, but Christ is the true Priest, Prophet, and King. The flock belongs to Christ, in whom we place all our trust. For this reason, in these days while we are without a Pope, we are still being shepherded by Christ the Good Shepherd. In these days, we pray for the Cardinals who will be gathering this week in Rome to elect a new Pope. We also pray for the man who will be our next Pope, that he will live his ministry of shepherding Christ's flock by following the example of Peter and affirming with his whole being: "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you".

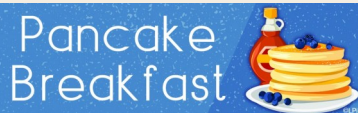

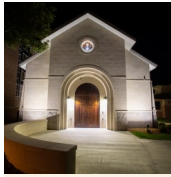


Rincón del Clero - Mensaje del Padre Daniel

El Tiempo de Pascua, que es el período entre la Pascua y Pentecostés, es uno de mis momentos favoritos del año. Hay un sentimiento general de entusiasmo y alegría por la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor que impregna otras celebraciones gozosas durante esta época del año: graduaciones, Primeras Comuniones, Confirmaciones y muchos otros eventos maravillosos. Lo que contribuye a este entusiasmo, en mi experiencia personal, es el impulso que se va construyendo desde la Pascua hasta la celebración de Pentecostés. Durante estos cincuenta días, las lecturas de la Misa nos ofrecen una visión del modo en que Cristo fue formando Su Iglesia. Este domingo, nuestras lecturas de las Escrituras nos dan un vistazo de cómo Cristo formó el corazón de San Pedro para ser el primer Santo Padre.

Nuestra lectura del Evangelio nos presenta ese hermoso relato de Jesús conversando con Simón Pedro. El hecho de que Jesús le pregunte tres veces a Pedro revierte las tres negaciones que Pedro hizo de Él. Jesús luego encomienda Sus ovejas al cuidado de Pedro, simbolizando así que Cristo confía los miembros de Su Cuerpo, la Iglesia, al cuidado vigilante del Papa. Cristo forma el corazón de Pedro inspirándolo en el amor. Este amor no es abstracto, sino que se concreta en el cuidado que Pedro debe tener por el rebaño que Cristo le confía. Curiosamente, a Pedro no se le entrega el rebaño como propiedad; solo se le encomienda alimentarlo y apacentarlo. Las ovejas siguen perteneciendo al rebaño de Cristo. Pedro ha sido puesto al frente de las ovejas para cuidarlas y protegerlas, pero siguen siendo ovejas de Cristo. No existe el "rebaño de Pedro". Así, Pedro y todos los Papas después de él son llamados a amar a Cristo principalmente a través de su misión de cuidar a los fieles.

Por eso otro título para el Papa es "**Vicario de Cristo**". Un "**vicario**" es aquel que actúa en nombre de otro. El Papa santifica, enseña y gobierna en nombre de Cristo, pero Cristo es el verdadero Sacerdote, Profeta y Rey. El rebaño pertenece a Cristo, en quien depositamos toda nuestra confianza. Por esta razón, en estos días en que estamos sin Papa, seguimos siendo pastoreados por Cristo, el Buen Pastor. En estos días, oramos por los Cardenales que se reunirán esta semana en Roma para elegir a un nuevo Papa. También oramos por el hombre que será nuestro próximo Papa, para que viva su ministerio de pastorear el rebaño de Cristo siguiendo el ejemplo de Pedro y afirmando con todo su ser: "Sí, Señor, tú sabes que te amo".

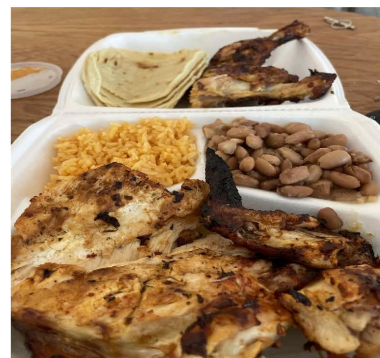

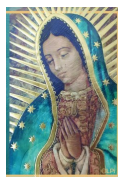
