PARISH SAFETY

Recent acts of violence directed against houses of worship and schools across the country have shown that the places we have traditionally thought of as being “safe havens” for us and our children are no longer immune to these serious threats.

Although we are aware of no threats against our church, campus or school, we are committed to ensuring the continuing safety of our parishioners, students, staff and visitors. For that reason, we have undertaken a security evaluation of the entire Holy Spirit campus and its many activities.

Based on our assessment, we are currently enhancing the security posture of our school, church, chapel, parish life center and office areas as prudent preventive measures. These measures have already begun in the school and will begin in the church, chapel, parish life center and office areas in the very near future. Most of them will have no effect on our regularly scheduled liturgies and other activities. Some of them are purely procedural and others will be improved physical security devices, including lights, locks, keys and cameras. An increased presence of police officers on and around the campus is also being implemented.

The flow of people in and through the church, chapel, parish life center and office areas, for liturgical services and other routine activities, will be redirected in order to assure the safety of our staff and everyone visiting our campus. This may result in some minimal inconvenience but will do much to keep us all safe and secure.

In addition to the above security measures, we have a couple of safety reminders to share.

- Be sure not to leave valuable things such as purses, wallets, phones, tablets, etc. visible in your vehicle.
- Always accompany small children while in church or on campus. Especially, in restrooms and other areas where they will be out of sight. Young children should be always accompanied by a parent.
- During Parish Activities and Mass, park only in designated parking spots (not on the curb along Tiger Drive), and reserve the handicap parking spots for people who truly need them.

We ask for your support and cooperation as we make the needed upgrades to our policies, procedures and campus. Thank you for your help and understanding!

SEGURIDAD PARROQUIAL

Los recientes actos de violencia dirigidos contra lugares de culto y escuelas en todo el país han demostrado que los espacios que tradicionalmente considerábamos “refugios seguros” para nosotros y nuestros hijos ya no son inmunes a estas graves amenazas.

Aunque no tenemos conocimiento de amenazas contra nuestra iglesia, campus o escuela, estamos comprometidos a garantizar la seguridad continua de nuestros feligreses, estudiantes, personal y visitantes. Por esta razón, hemos realizado una evaluación de seguridad de todo el campus de Holy Spirit y de sus diversas actividades.

Con base en esta evaluación, actualmente estamos reforzando la seguridad de nuestra escuela, iglesia, capilla, centro de vida parroquial y áreas de oficinas como medidas preventivas prudentes. Estas medidas ya han comenzado en la escuela y se implementarán en la iglesia, capilla, centro de vida parroquial y áreas de oficinas en un futuro muy cercano. La mayoría no afectará nuestras liturgias y actividades programadas regularmente. Algunas son de carácter procedimental y otras incluyen mejoras en los dispositivos físicos de seguridad, como iluminación, cerraduras, llaves y cámaras. También se está implementando una mayor presencia de oficiales de policía dentro y alrededor del campus.

El flujo de personas dentro y a través de la iglesia, capilla, centro de vida parroquial y áreas de oficinas, tanto para servicios litúrgicos como para otras actividades rutinarias, será redirigido para garantizar la seguridad de nuestro personal y de todos los que visitan nuestro campus. Esto puede ocasionar algunas molestias mínimas, pero contribuirá significativamente a mantenernos seguros y protegidos.

Además de las medidas de seguridad mencionadas, queremos compartir algunos recordatorios importantes:

- Procure no dejar objetos de valor como carteras, billeteras, teléfonos, tabletas, etc., visibles dentro de su vehículo.
- Acompañe siempre a los niños pequeños mientras estén en la iglesia o en el campus, especialmente en los baños y en otras áreas donde puedan quedar fuera de la vista. Los niños pequeños deben estar siempre acompañados por un padre o tutor.
- Durante las actividades parroquiales y la Misa, estacione únicamente en los espacios designados (no en la acera a lo largo de Tiger Drive) y reserve los espacios de estacionamiento para personas con discapacidad para quienes realmente los necesiten.

Les pedimos su apoyo y cooperación mientras realizamos las actualizaciones necesarias a nuestras políticas, procedimientos y al campus. ¡Gracias por su ayuda y comprensión!


